Truthsips Intro:

In this book, *A Divine Revelation of Hell*, the author, Mary K. Baxter, describes how she received revelations from the Lord Jesus during a time of intense prayer over the course of 40 days. Seeking to warn those who still have time, she recounts how her spirit was taken into a literal place of fire, brimstone and torment where she witnessed the unimaginable suffering of those who did not receive Jesus as their Savior or truly live for Him.

- that hell has a body like that of a human being with legs, arms, and a heart;
- how Jesus warned many people about the dangers of hell but they refused to take heed and suffered the consequences; and
- what those on earth can do now so that they and others avoid this place before it's too late.

Key Point & Insight #1: Hell has a body.

Hell has a body like that of a human being, with arms, legs and a belly. When people first arrive in hell, they enter the jaws of hell where they are escorted by demons into their intended destination.

Hell is located in the center of the earth and its body lies on its back. Within the belly of hell is a heart like that of a human heart, pumping and distributing not blood but horns that go into the earth. Through the horns, evil spirits and demons travel to the surface of the earth. Their goal is to beguile people to do evil and wreak havoc in homes, churches, hospitals and all kinds of places on the earth.

Truthsips Note: According to the author, Jesus did not show her everything in hell but He showed her much. She recounts traveling to the left and right arms of hell, the belly of hell and the jaws of hell.

There are different torments for different people according to the types of sins they committed. These torments are located in different places throughout the body of hell.

There is no water, food, or sleep to escape the unending torment lost souls experience in hell. Life, love or hope do not exist in this place. Everything is dead including the trees, grass and dirt.

Hell is a place of fire, torment, deep darkness, incredible filth, horrible odors, and a host of evil spiritual creatures traversing through its many parts. Screeching sounds can be heard from both people and spiritual beings in hell.

Key Point & Insight #2: The sights and horrors of hell are unimaginable and unending.

In hell, people have their physical senses. They can see, hear, taste, smell and touch; these senses are magnified to a higher level than a person's senses here on earth.

The sights in hell are varied and hideous and include huge snakes; rats; wild boar;, large demons the size of grizzly bears; small demons; shadowy figures; evil spirits; worms and much more.

This is real and not imaginary. Evil forces are rampant.

Hell has different places, including a place of outer darkness. There are also funnels protruding out of the earth and spinning over the earth; these are gateways to hell.



Most people in hell have a skeletal body with a soul that resembles a dirty gray mist that can be seen inside their body. Worms crawl in and out of their skeletal frames.

Many souls in hell are confined to pits of fire and rivers of fire of blood along with other torments.

Within the heart of hell are cells, like prison cells, where people who practiced witchcraft or were in the occult are confined.

Some people in hell thought their sins of witchcraft or murder were too big for Jesus to forgive but they were not. If they had repented, Jesus could have saved them and their family.

Truthsips Note: What we do affects not only us but those around us including our family members.

Key Point & Insight #3: People of all types end up in hell, and for many reasons.

Truthsips Note: The author recalls how she and Jesus stopped many times to speak with some of those who were forever lost in hell.

One lady had been in hell since Moses' time. This particular lady was a soothsayer and a witch and taught others to practice witchcraft. During their visit, Jesus told the lady that if she had repented, God would have forgiven her.

Some people thought their sins were too big for God to forgive and never turned to Him.

Some made light of the gospel message and never received Jesus as Savior.

There were some who had one foot in the kingdom of God and one foot in the world, hoping they could ride the fence and serve both God and Satan.

Some people thought they had an unlimited amount of grace and would be able to pick and choose when they serve God.

People falsely comforted themselves with such deceptive thoughts as:

I can serve God tomorrow. I can serve God later. I have plenty of time to serve God.

They were wrong.



Some people engaged in adulterous affairs and sexual sins.

Some Christians had pleasure in partying and drinking and went back into the world and served Satan.

Then there were some, including church members, who refused to forgive others or who lied, cheated, stole and engaged in the works of flesh. Many had heard God's word of salvation but rejected Him.

There were also ministers who did not preach the truth or took advantage of their congregation for financial gain.

There were others who worshipped other gods or idols that cannot save them.

Some of those who Jesus spoke with in hell were unexpectedly killed in car accidents, thinking they had time to get right but they did not.

The people in hell are there forever.

There were also those who were unwilling to endure the suffering and persecution that come with serving Jesus, not realizing that the wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ.

Satan is relentless in his pursuit to snatch someone's soul into hell. He works tirelessly scheming day and night to deceive people and cause men and women to forsake God.

Key Point & Insight #4: God gives people many opportunities to repent before they die.

God will send his followers to a person many times to share the good news of Jesus and the hope He brings to save and restore mankind. Some people ignore it; others refuse to believe it.

One man had committed murder and thought his sin was too egregious for God to forgive him. Instead of receiving God's love and mercy, which God has offered to everyone, the man continued to sin and then died in his sins.

Truthsips Note: The author describes over fifteen conversations Jesus had with those in hell as they stopped and talked with some who cried out to Him as He passed by.



A lot of the people, upon seeing Jesus, said they were hoping Jesus would come back for them and rescue them out of hell, though they soon realized that was not the reason He was there.

Some offered up pleas of repentance, stating that they wanted a second chance and would now serve God if given the opportunity. They too found out it was too late.

Jesus gave many warnings to people before they died and went to hell. There are people God had called as a child, through their teenage years, and then as an adult yet they refused to receive His gift of salvation and repent of their ways. They put it off thinking they could do it later only to find out it was too late.

Some people thought they didn't need God and were blinded by their money, beauty, fame or reputation – things that can fade or erode over time and have no eternal value.

God pleads with people time and time again to receive His love and repent of their ways. He tries to draw them with His Spirit but they still reject Him. God sent His servants many times to share the hope and gospel of Jesus but many did not take heed. There are some Jesus came to personally yet they would not repent.

People too often forsake the promises of salvation for the pleasures of sin, not knowing that they are being deceived by Satan.

Key Point & Insight #5: God can reveal unknown and future events through visions.

Truthsips Note: In addition to having many visits to hell, the author also shares of numerous visions she received, some which she could share and others she was instructed not to reveal.

Vision #1: There was a large disk from which a paralyzing force emanated. Demons and evil spirits appeared to be coming out of hell by way of an escalator that was part of this disk.

Vision #2: There was a river of fire and blood in which many souls were chained together. Those who engaged in sexual sins committed against their own kind – men with men and women with women – were here.

Vision #3: There were people who were on earth during the time of the beast that had the number 666 written on their foreheads or hands. They were treated very inhumanely. Those who take the mark of the beast are destined for hell.



Key Point & Insight #6: There is a spiritual war being waged between good and evil.

There is a spiritual battle of invisible forces – God versus Satan, light versus darkness, good versus evil – that impacts and determines what happens here on the earth.

Satan is clever and uses many tactics to entrap people. He gives orders to his demons to deceive and destroy as many as possible.

In Jesus, believers have power over the forces and works of Satan. God's people should use the name of Jesus. The name of Jesus will deliver people and set them free.

As believers pray in Jesus' name and pray in faith, evil spirits lose their power. God's angels come and fight against the demonic powers in the air and destroy them.

On the other hand, when believers begin to believe Satan's lies over God's truth, Satan's forces prevail.

You must have faith in God and not agree with anything contrary to what God has said in His word.

Truthsips Note: We walk by faith and not by sight. (2 Corinthians 5:7)

Key Point & Insight #7: God's power is greater than Satan's power.

There are many demons and evil spirits on the earth but they are afraid of Christians who exercise their authority in Jesus.

Truthsips Note: The author recounts how she witnessed a group of demons gathered together and overheard one demon speak to another demon.

The demons spoke of how, when they come from hell to the earth, they have to look out for believers in Jesus who know Jesus and the power they have in Him since such believers have the power to cast them out. Another demon then said they would avoid going to those believers.

God has His angels constantly watching over believers as well as the unsaved to protect them from what Satan and his evil forces would try to do against them.



God's people have many weapons which include: binding Satan and his forces, praying in faith, praying in one accord with other believers, and praising and thanking God. All of these are spiritual weapons that can be used to defeat Satan's power.

Angels will be deployed as God's children believe and pray. The works of darkness will be destroyed. Conversely, when saints don't believe God and don't pray, Satan's forces can defeat them. Faith in God is so important. Believe God and take His word at face value. Prayer is so important. Praise is so important and will cause Satan's forces to retreat.

Prayer in faith and in Jesus' name brings in the angels of God and people are delivered. As people are delivered, men and women praise God and this praise brings more victories. When people don't see their prayers answered right away and then don't praise God, Satan's forces advance.

Key Point & Insight #8: God is raising up an end-time army.

Truthsips Note: The author describes how the Lord showed her a giant clock over the whole earth with the minute hand at 3 minutes before twelve o'clock. Twelve o'clock is indicative of the time that Jesus will return. The time of the end may be closer than we think.

Before the time of the beast, God will raise up an army.

Although many of God's people are asleep, God's is raising up an end-time army that will stand for truth and do mighty exploits.

Be watchful, prayerful, love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength. Love your neighbor as yourself. Stay holy and pure before God.

If you have sin in your life, repent and ask God to forgive you.

If you are a minister of God's word, don't water down the word to be popular with lukewarm Christians. Stick with what is in the Bible and stand for truth. Don't steal from God's people.



God wants people to repent before it is too late. Jesus is the way of escape from hell and eternal damnation. Turn to Him now, live for Him and remain steadfast until the end.

God is raising up an army in the last days who will stand for truth and not bow their knee to the pressures of the world. God is looking for those who will serve Him will all their heart and He will choose those whom the world would least expect. Those in this army of God will reveal His power to those on the earth and defeat the powers of Satan.

Final Summary:

The author notes that you should read this book, *A Divine Revelation of Hell*, in conjunction with the Bible. One constant theme throughout its pages is that God does not want people to go to hell and has made a way of escape through Jesus. Jesus is real. Heaven and hell are real. The torments and suffering in hell are real. A person can have faith in Jesus' death and sacrifice on the cross for their sins, and ask Him to come into their heart. If you sin, you can confess your sin before a merciful and forgiving God who is able and just to forgive your sins. Read your Bible each day, pray to God regularly, gather with a body of true believers and seek to give your whole life to Jesus while you still have time.

- 1. If you were to die tonight, do you know what would happen to you or where you would go?
- 2. If the (spiritual) clock was previously at 3 minutes before twelve o'clock over 40 years ago, where is the minute hand now? How much time do we have left before the return of Christ?
- 3. Who are 3 people you can share Jesus with this week or begin to fervently pray for that they would be saved?
